Maths Homework Activity - Money

Next week the children will be exploring money in maths lessons. Please could your child bring into school a named purse/wallet, (something with a zip that is easily opened to get coins out of). Inside, please could they have the following coins:

• 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p, 20p, 50p, £1, £2.

It would be great if they could have five 1p coins, and five 2p coins, and a few of the lower value coins, (not 50p and above).

We feel that the children gain so much more from handling real coins/money and they find it quite exciting that they have their own purse with 'real' money inside. In school we do have plastic coins so please don't worry if you can't provide this.

Their purses/wallets will be kept in the classroom and used in lessons and other cross curricular activities. They will learn how to be responsible for their purse/wallet and the money inside. With money being used less and less in our everyday lives, it will be a good opportunity for the children to be introduced to handling money.
