

Homework Activities








Over the next few weeks please can you have some fun at home with shapes. After half term, the children will be continuing their learning from Reception where they were introduced to the names of 'solid' shapes, (3D), and 'flat' shapes, (2D).


3-DIMENSIONAL SHAPES

With your support we would like your child to find 'real life' examples of 3D shapes in the home and outside and take photos of these shapes, print them out and label them. Please create an A4 size poster or collage of this work, named, to hand in no later than 6th November. It would be useful if you could keep the labelled 3D objects you find so your child can refer to them regularly, which will help to embed their knowledge. The 3-dimensional shapes we focus on in year 1 are: cube, cylinder, cuboid, pyramid, cone and sphere.



2-DIMENSIONAL SHAPES

We would like your child to draw and label a selection of 2D shapes. Please could this work be completed on a sheet of named A4 paper, and handed in no later than 6th November. Again, please keep a copy of their work, (perhaps take a photo of it and print it out), and see if they can spot these shapes around the home or when they are out and about. It is always more beneficial if children can relate to shapes they learn about in their every-day environment. The 2-dimensional shapes we focus on in year 1 are: rectangle, circle, square and triangle.

Finally, ask your child to have some fun drawing or making pictures of familiar objects only using the above shapes. Perhaps try and draw/create a bus, train or rocket attempting to use at least three of the above shapes. How creative can they be?! Hand in, on named A4 paper no later than 6th November.
