Maths

This half term we will be learning about multiplication and division.

In particular we will focus on:

- recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables, including recognising odd and even numbers
- calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division within the multiplication tables and write them using the multiplication (x), division (÷) and equals (=) signs
- show that multiplication of two numbers can be done in any order (commutative) and division of one number by another cannot

History/Geography

We will be learning about The United Kingdom, the four countries it is made up of and their flags.

We will then move onto learning about the Isle of Coll which is in the Western Hebrides of Scotland,

We will use the Katie Morag stories to help us learn about Human and Physical geography.

Music

We will listen to and learn about the national anthems of each country of the United Kingdom.

Science

Plants

We will learn about the lifecycle of plants by observing and describing seeds and bulbs growing into mature plants.

We will develop our scientific enquiry skills by setting up experiments to find out about how different factors affect plant growth e.g. amount of sunlight.
