

Geography

The children will use globes & maps to locate the World's seven continents & five oceans. They will travel to each continent exploring the climate, animals, physical features, landmarks and traditions along the way.

Science

The children will be learning about animals, describing the features of different animals and sorting them by these features e.g. mammal, fish, bird, reptile, amphibian, and insect. They will be learning about what animals eat and classifying them into carnivore, herbivore, and omnivore.

Art

The children will look at paintings by Henri Rousseau. They will create their own painting in his style. The children will also use a variety of media to create artwork linked to the animals and landmarks they find on their travels around the World.

DT

The children will follow a recipe, make, taste and evaluate food from countries they travel to.

Maths

This half term the children will be continuing to use their calculation skills to add and subtract numbers. They will be reinforcing their knowledge of place value within the range of 50. The children will be problem solving and continuing to learn how to explain their thinking.

P.E. and Games
