Geography/History

Throughout the topic the children will:

- look at simple timelines including when dinosaurs were alive, when medieval castles were built and their lives so far.
- explore how we know dinosaurs existed and how fossils are formed.
- find out about the life of Mary Anning and her important role in the history of fossil finding.
- look at the geography of Jordans' Village and create their own maps. They will use their findings to think of suitable places for a baby dinosaur to live.

Maths

This term the children will be continuing to use their calculation skills to add and subtract numbers as well as beginning to understand multiplication and division. The children will be problem solving and continuing to learn how to explain their thinking.

PSHE

Continuing with exploring how to keep our wellbeing high, and look after ourselves.

R.E.

We will be exploring various religions and their place of worship.

Science

The children will be learning about the seasons and how animals adapt throughout the four seasons. They will also be exploring minibeasts.
