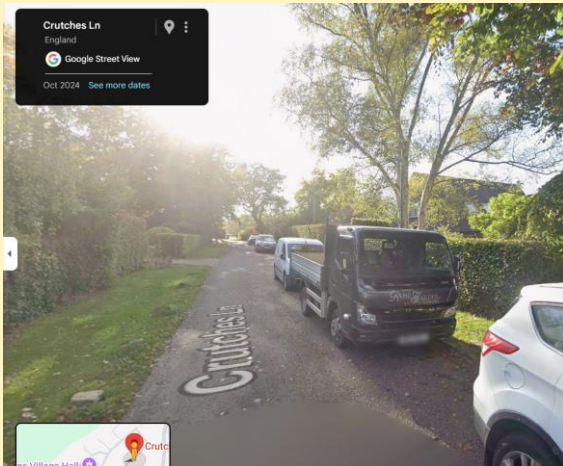
Jordans Village Page
