We really enjoyed discussing your wonderful children with you at the parent consultations this week.



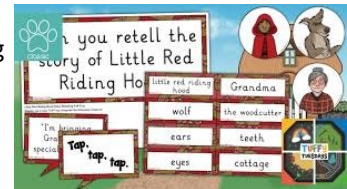
TRIPS AND VISITS

FOX CLASS

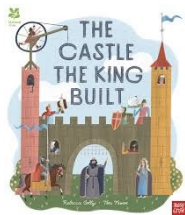

OWL CLASS

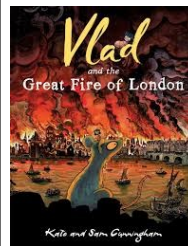
In Owl Class this week we have worked really hard. In DT & Cooking we have looked

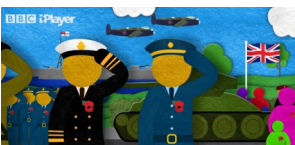
