Samuel Pepys

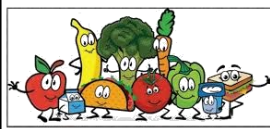
In Drama lessons this week, Deer Class has been re-enacting the Great Fire of London. We have also been learning about Samuel
