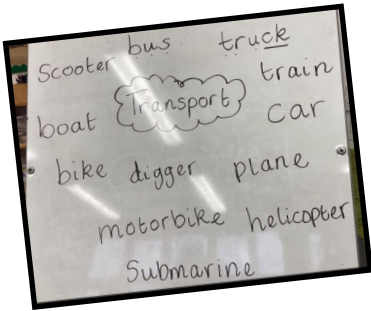


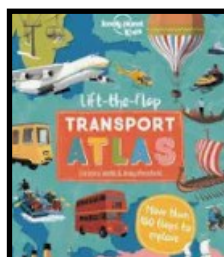
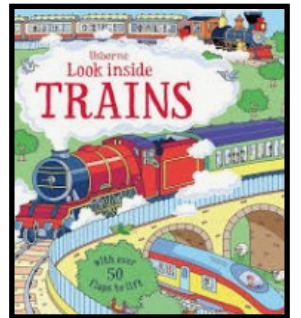

## CHILDREN IN NEED

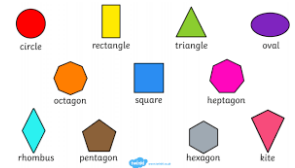

## FOX CLASS

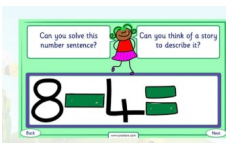
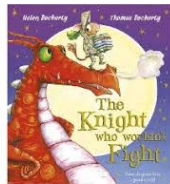
