






JORDANS SCHOOL CLASS NEWS




Fox Class





AFTER SCHOOL PLAYDATES

Parent Checklist

Arranging time for your child to have a playdate with a friend can be an excellent opportunity for them to develop friendships and social skills.

Here are some top tips from parents, teachers and children's charities:

Before the Playdate

- ✓ Confirm supervision: Ensure an adult you know and trust will be present and attentive.
- ✓ Check the environment: Ask about pets, pools, trampolines, or other risks.
- ✓ Share health info: Provide allergy, medical, or dietary needs.
- ✓ Exchange contacts: Swap phone numbers and emergency details.
- ✓ Agree on rules: Discuss screen time, outdoor play, and acceptable games.
- ✓ Pass on the car seat / booster seat

During the Playdate

- ✓ Snacks & meals: Confirm food is safe for all children.
- ✓ Regular check ins: Adults should monitor play and step in if needed.
- ✓ Digital safety: Clarify device use and online access.
- ✓ Respect boundaries: Remind children to ask before using toys or entering rooms.



Safety

- ✓ Walking to and from the car – set expectations, hold hands, walk together safely.
- ✓ First aid – keep a home first aid kit and quick guidebook to refer to in an emergency.
- ✓ Emergency plan: Agree on what to do if a child gets hurt.

After the Playdate

- ✓ Check in with your child: Ask how they felt and if anything worried them.
- ✓ Share feedback: Communicate with the other parent about what went well.

Quick Reminders

- ✓ On the first occasion, go with your child so you can get to know each other as families.
- ✓ Inform the school that your child is going home with someone else.
- ✓ Share allergies and medical info every time.
- ✓ Empower children to say “no” if uncomfortable.
