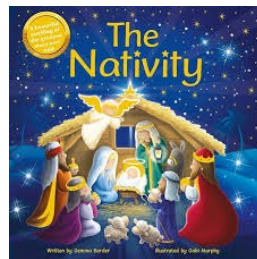
## THE SELFISH GIANT

## YR 2—GREAT FIRE OF LONDON WORKSHOP

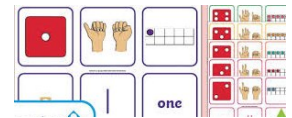
The children in Deer Class are really looking forward to their in-school workshop next Wednesday about The Great Fire of London.

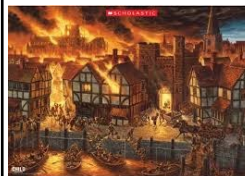
## OWL CLASS

The children can wear Christmas jumpers/mufti on Tuesday 17th December. We will also be having our Christmas picnic party lunch that day.



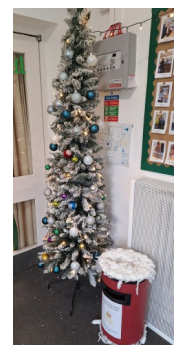
## YR 2 TO JORDANS LUNCH CLUB
