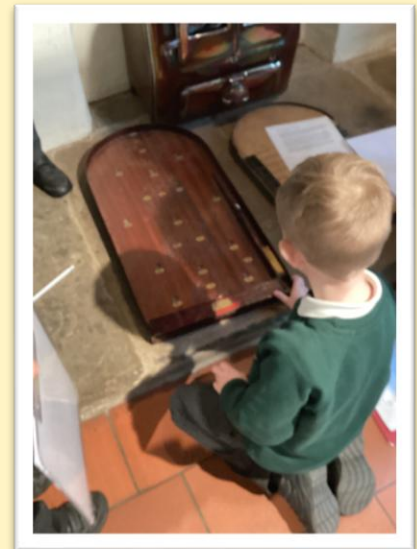
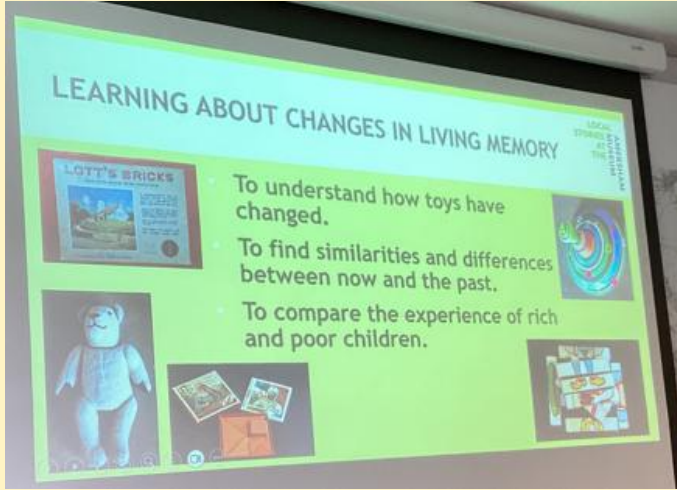

## CLASS NEWS



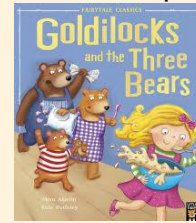
### Fox Class

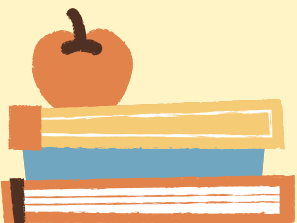

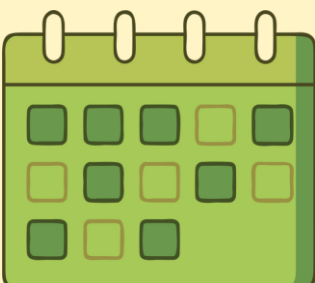

### GARDENING AND WILDLIFE



Nationally, gardens total 23 million covering an area of around 433,000 hectares. This is bigger than Exmoor, Dartmoor and the Lake District National Parks and Norfolk Broads put together! Imagine if everybody in the UK made a few small changes in their garden to help our British wildlife? We could create a patchwork of habitats from Hodgemoor Woods to Crutches Woods and beyond - increasing safe spaces for wildlife to survive and thrive.

A new initiative from Jordans Biodiversity Group and Jordans Horticultural Society is being set up to support exactly this. Expect knowledge sharing social events, expert demonstrations and more!

Please come to our launch on **Saturday 21st March at 3pm in Jordans Village Hall**. There will be top tips for gardening for wildlife and a seed swap. Bring your excess seeds or make a donation and pick up a bargain. (If you are bringing seeds to swap please bring them in labelled paper packages/envelopes and the year you collected them. Packages should contain enough seeds for a small crop e.g. 5-10 tomato seeds, 20 sweet peas.)

If every gardener could make just a few changes in their own space, collaborate with a neighbour to create green corridors, or work collectively to make our villages green hubs, we will make a massive difference to nature.
