## CHRISTMAS MUFTI

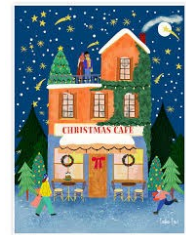

## FOX CLASS

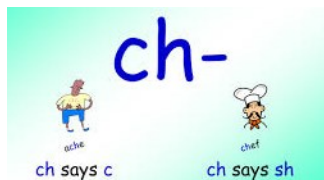
