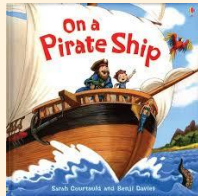


# JORDANS SCHOOL CLASS NEWS

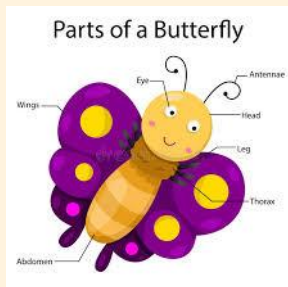
## Owl Class











# JORDANS SCHOOL BELONGING





Lessons in primary school build on the previous one...



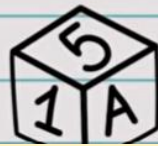
...and children need to **learn the basics** before moving on to the next lesson in the sequence.



From understanding phonics, to reading full sentences, then reading their first book...



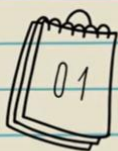
...lessons move from **simple** to more **complex** ideas and if missed, it can be difficult for children to catch up...

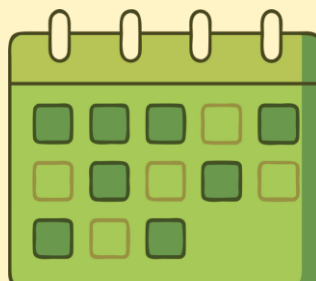
