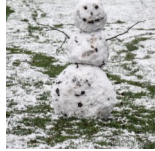

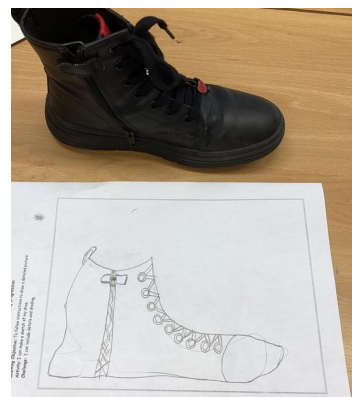
OWL CLASS
