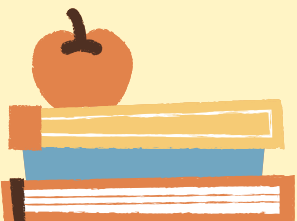

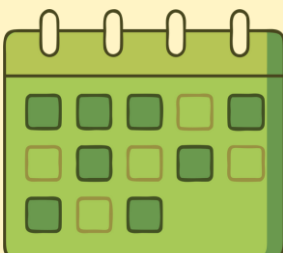

Summer Activities 2026

Dear Parents,

For those who might not know me, I'm Janna and I work with the two churches in Seer Green with children and families and run community-wide events and activities during the year. This summer we are hosting a variety of activities during the summer holidays. These are supported by Holy Trinity and Seer Green Baptist Church, hosted at SGBC (HP9 2XG). Activities can be booked through eventbrite – helping us to be cashless and to provide the right number of resources for each event. Booking before the day is preferred and advisable, but places may be available on the day if we have not reached our capacity.

 **Messy Crafternoons Mondays** – 27th July, 3rd & 10th August 2.30-4.30pm Bring your children along for 2 hours of creative fun! Aimed at 3-10s. All children must be accompanied. Enjoy a range of different activities each week including DIY crafts, Lego, Hama, sand, playdough, glue, stickers and more! Cost £5 per child. Book places here

Family Fun Wednesdays 29th July, 5th & 12th August 10am – 12noon, Aimed at 0-7s (ish) accompanied by their parent/carer.

You can only book one session at a time (sorry the system won't let you book multiple dates on one transaction so if you want to attend multiple sessions you will need to do separate transactions). **You only need one ticket per family / group.** Please enter a donation for attending – minimum **£5 per child for Messy Crafternoons or £2.50 per person over 6 months per Family Fun session** Then add the names / ages of children attending and the name(s) of adults accompanying them.*

For the activities above, if you book and then are unable to attend, refunds can be requested before 8am on the day the activity takes place.

We are also hosting 'Little City,' an amazing role play city especially for under 6s.
