### About Us

Jordans Village Community Store is an independent community store, owned, operated and controlled by the Village. It is run by a combination of part-time staff and volunteers from the local community.

It started in a very small way in the front room of one of the early workers' cottages by the Village Green. In 1922, the brick building, now used as the Estate Office, was erected and a proper store opened.

The liquidation two years later of Jordans Village Industries Ltd, which threatened the Village's very existence, brought about the Store's closure; but almost immediately, some residents subscribed capital for opening a shop to take its place.

This took the form of a shed on land in front of the Village Hall and business was soon in full swing. In 1930, the Shop Committee felt justified in building a larger store on the site, which was further extended in 2002 and in 2022 we celebrated our centenary - not something many community stores are able to do!

The store is now a general grocers, with green groceries, an off-licence and a pop-up post office. It also serves as a natural meeting place for many of those living around the village, so why not come in and receive a warm welcome from our friendly staff and team of volunteers who help keep the shop up-and-running.

**FIRE DRILL**

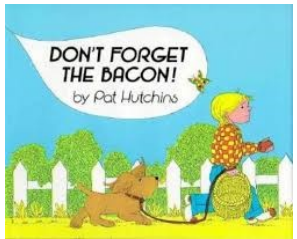

**FOX CLASS**

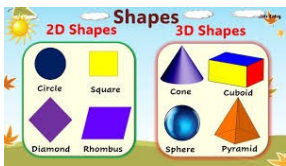

Teams should consist of no more than 8 people but if you have a smaller number, we can pair you up with another team on the night.

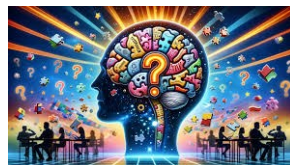
We are asking each team to bring a dessert which can be auctioned at the Auction of Puddings.
