CLASS NEWS



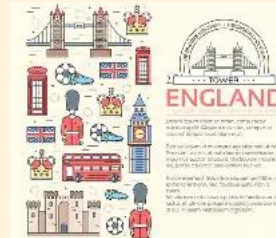
Fox Class
