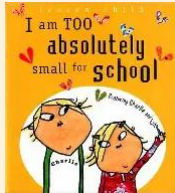

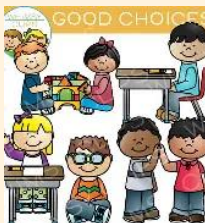
Owl Class

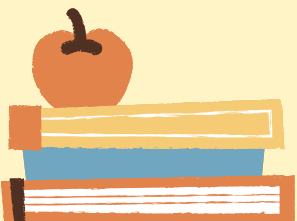

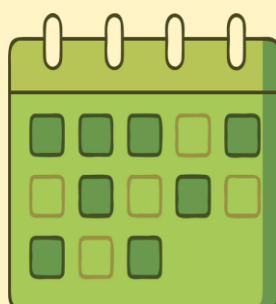
