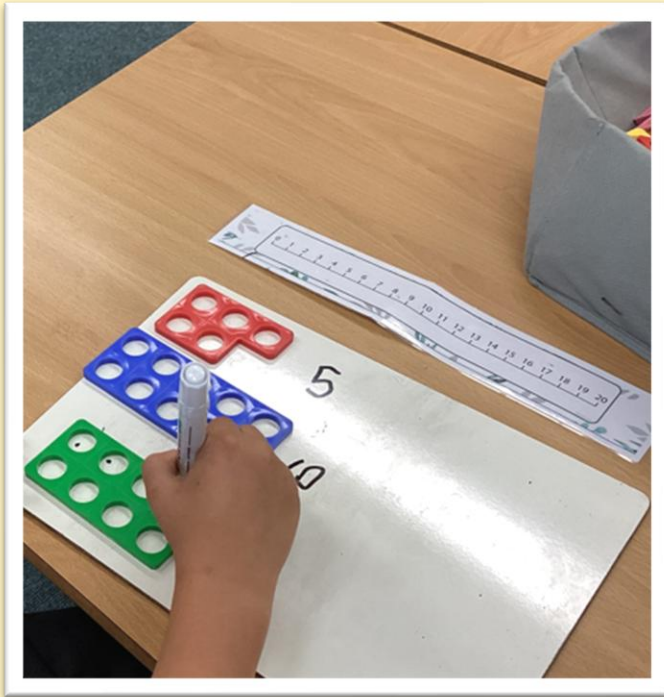

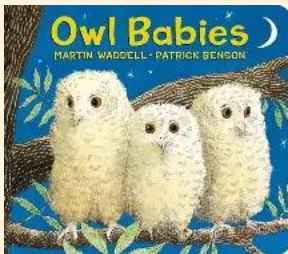

CLASS NEWS



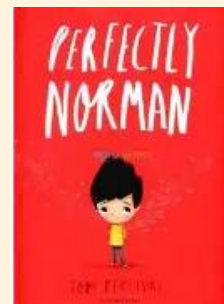
Fox Class

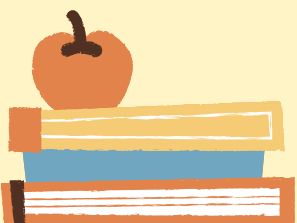

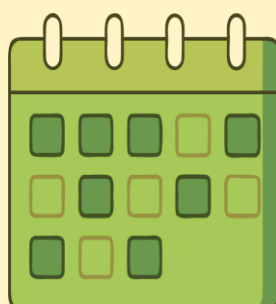

How do we celebrate birthdays at Jordans?

Birthdays are always a joyful part of school life at Jordans. When it's a child's special day, their class sings *Happy Birthday*, and at lunchtime they enjoy a special birthday placemat while the whole school joins in a celebratory song. It's a simple tradition that makes every child feel seen and valued.

To keep our celebrations fully inclusive, we kindly ask families not to send in cakes, sweets or food items, as these can exclude children with allergies or low sugar dietary needs. Instead, we have a lovely alternative that our children adore.

Families are warmly invited—if they wish—to donate a book to their child's class book corner. We add a personalised book plate, and the teacher (or a parent, if they'd like to come in) reads the story to the class. The book then becomes part of the class library for the rest of the year and continues to be enjoyed by future Jordans children. It's a wonderful way for your child to leave a little legacy.

We hope you enjoy being part of our Jordans birthday traditions, and that your child feels truly special on their day.

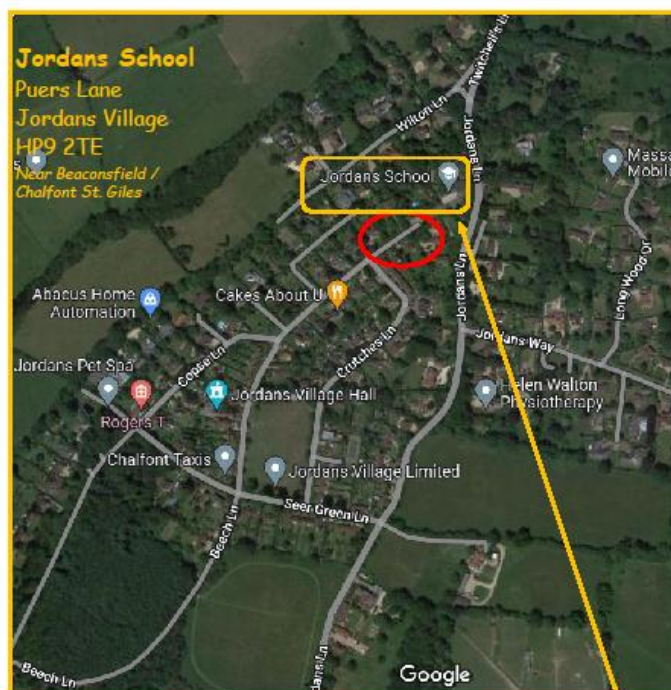
Thank you!
