



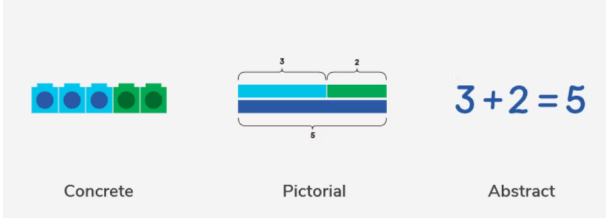

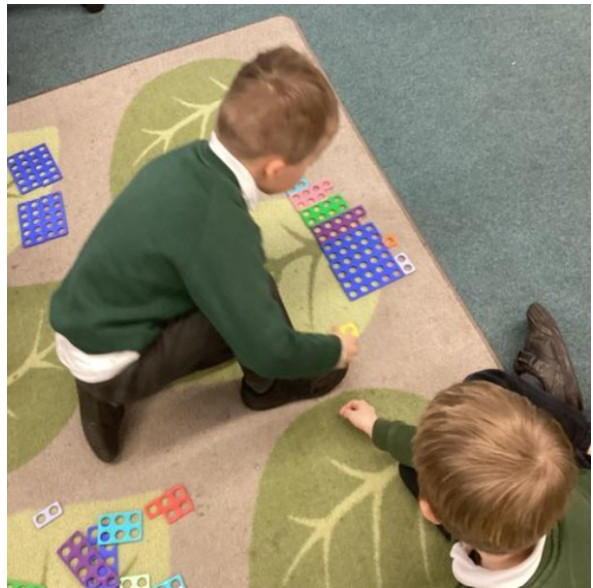

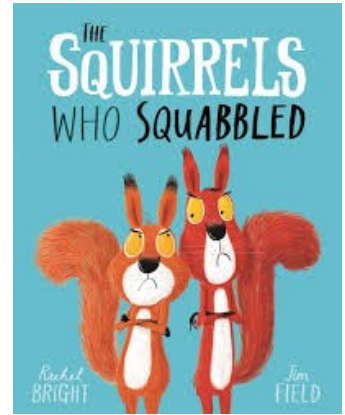

FOREST SCHOOL THIS WEEK

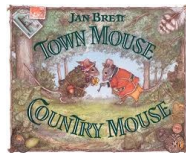

OWL CLASS

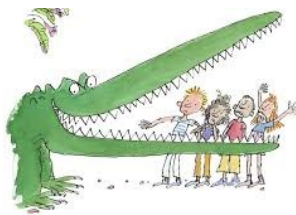


What a busy week we have had in Owl Class! In our Maths lessons we have been counting to 20. In our Phonics we have been learning

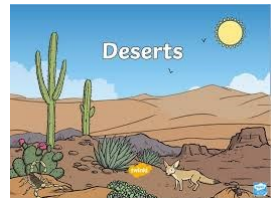
about "y" sounding as "ee". In D&T and Cooking we had a cheese tasting session. Fantastic work this week!
