FOX CLASS

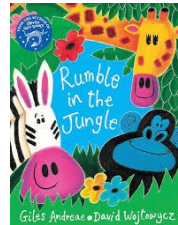
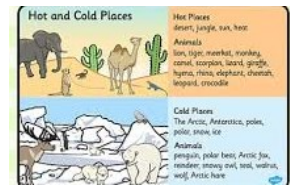
This week we have been thinking and talking about the similarities between the UK and China.
