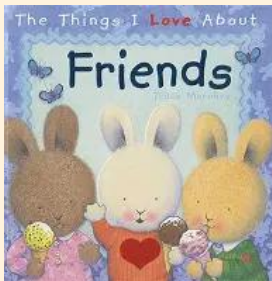

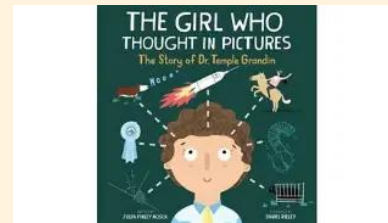
Fox Class

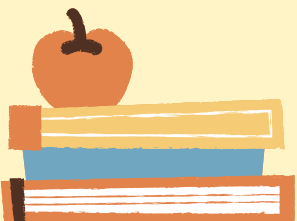

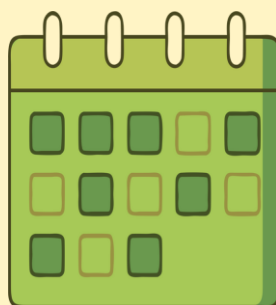
