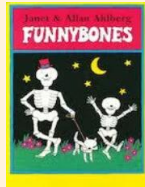


JORDANS SCHOOL CLASS NEWS

Owl Class

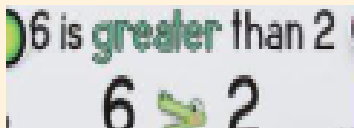

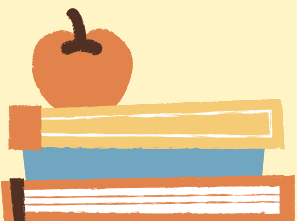

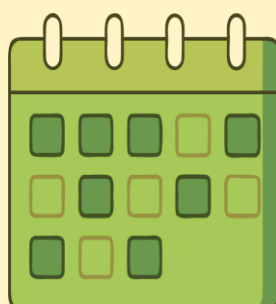
