

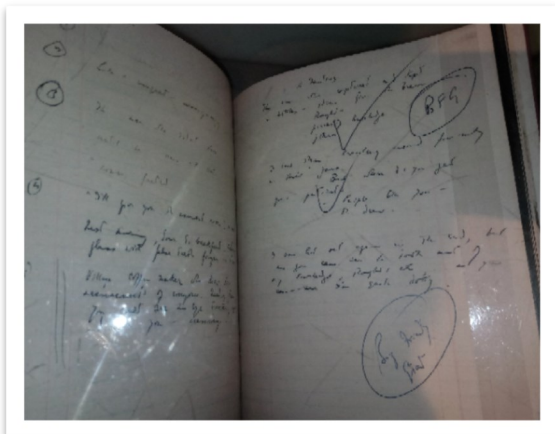
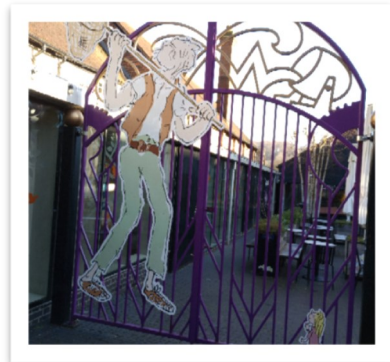

FOX CLASS


