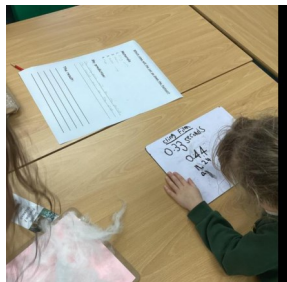

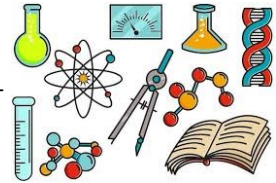

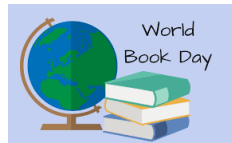
VALENTINES DAY MUFTI
