

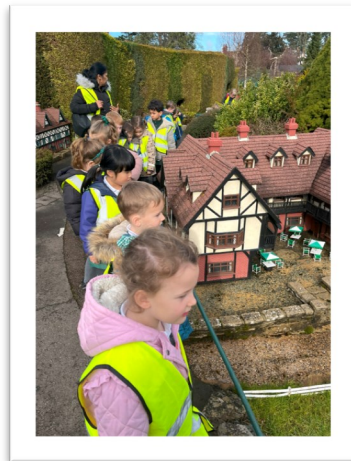


BEKONSCOT MODEL VISIT

There was so much to see and they particularly enjoyed watching the miniature trains go by and joining in the special workshop.





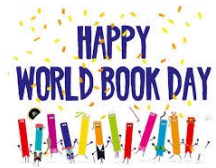

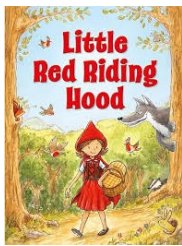
FOX CLASS

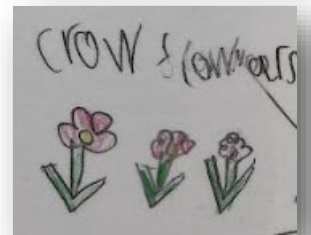
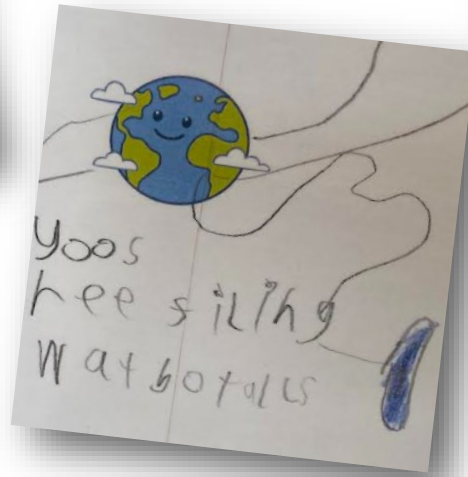
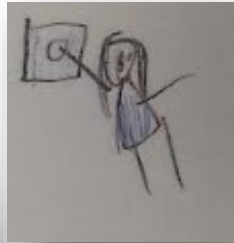

EASTER COMPETITIONS

We have two Easter competitions for the children to take part in. The first is our Decorate an Easter Egg competition. You can purchase a polystyrene egg via Parentmail and collect your egg from the school office any afternoon from Thursday 20th March to Thursday 27th March. Eggs cost £3 each. Your child can the decorate the egg in whatever way they would like. They can decorate it with paint, sequins, feathers or anything else of their choosing or they can turn their egg into an animal or famous character. In years gone by we have had Superman eggs, Harry Potter eggs and even dinosaurs! The only limit is their imagination. There will be a prize for the winner from each class and all entries must be brought into school on or by Monday 31st March. Please allow the children to decorate their egg themselves with only minimal input from adults. Thank you.
