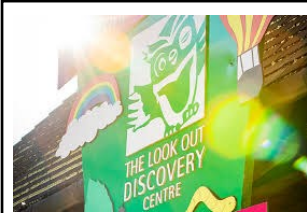


Owl Class visit the Discovery Centre

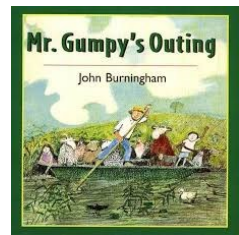

FOX CLASS

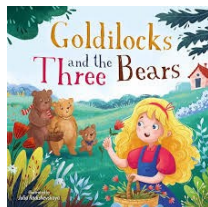

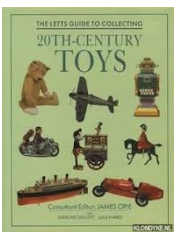


OWL CLASS

Our traditional tale this week has been Goldilocks and the Three Bears. We have all enjoyed this story. In Maths we have been

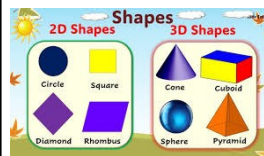


looking at length and height and we have had a fantastic time in History lessons looking at 20th Century toys. Good learning Owls!
