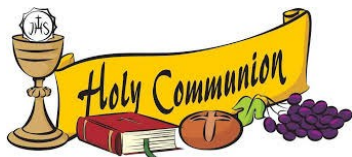


OWL CLASS

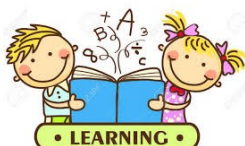
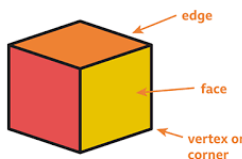


Holy Communion. Well done Owls, super work!
