

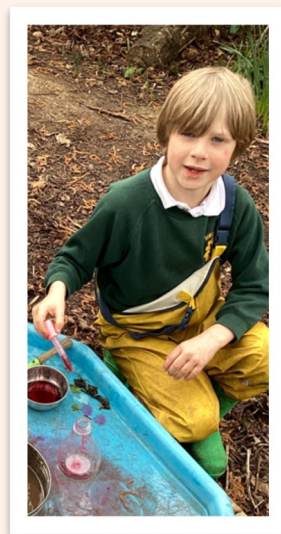

Please remember we break up for Easter next Friday 4th April at **2pm** instead of the usual 3pm. The children return to school on Tuesday 22nd April. Thank you.

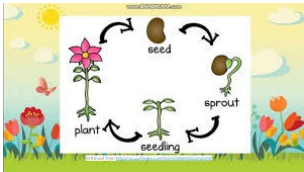


Remember that the clocks 'Spring forward' an hour on Sunday morning and our evenings will finally be getting lighter... hooray!

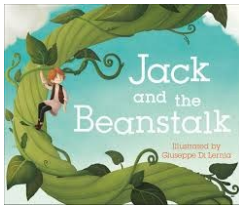
**MOTHERING SUNDAY AND SPRINGING FORWARD!**  
We hope you all have a fantastic Mother's Day on Sunday, spending time with your families and (hopefully) being pampered.



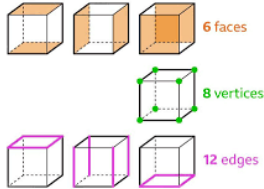
**FOX CLASS**

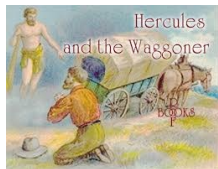

Scarecrows can be traditional or made from any medium - the scarecrow(s) must be durable and designed to live outdoors and survive whatever the great British weather treats us to that weekend.
