


EASTER ASSEMBLIES






SUNFLOWERS

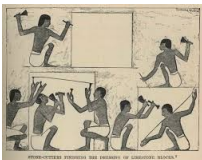

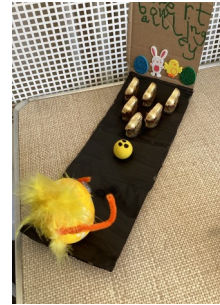
