

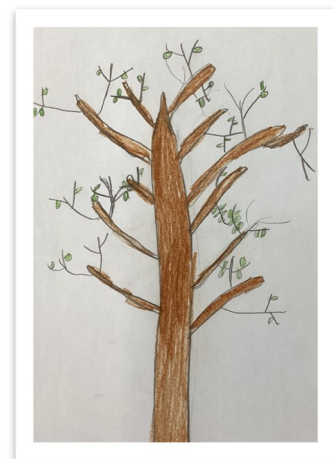

Thank you to everyone who took part in our Comic Relief multi day before Easter. Your generous donations helped contribute towards the **£180** Jordans School raised. Thank you!



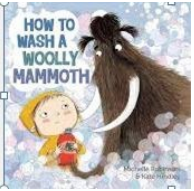
FOX CLASS

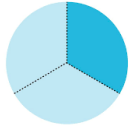
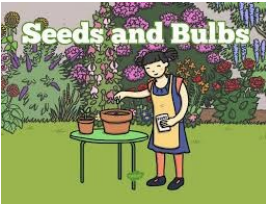
OWL CLASS
