SCHOOL COOK

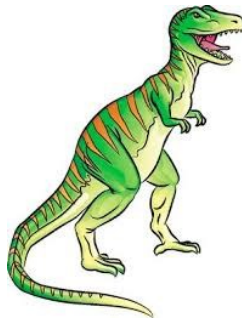

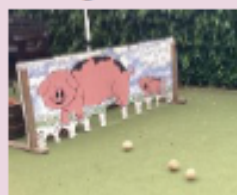
Hook a Duck

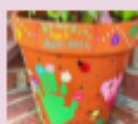
Bowling for Bacon

Mrs Pandya & Mrs Kara-Puni will be face painting!

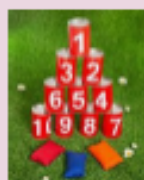
Marble Challenge

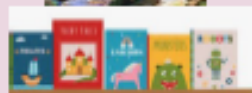

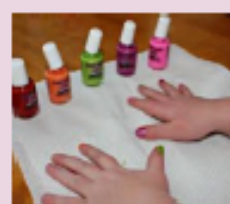
