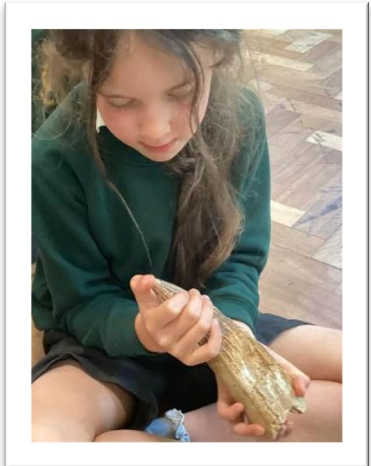
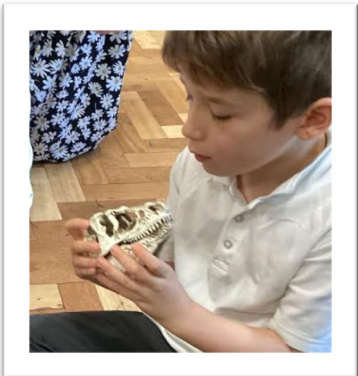
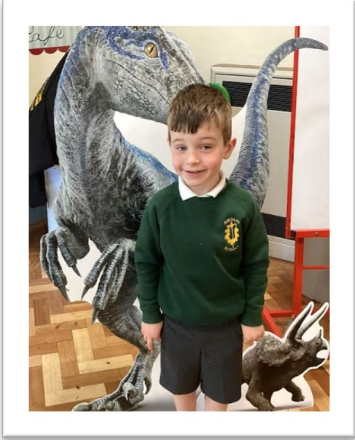




OWL CLASS - DINOSAURS AND FOSSILS

FOX CLASS

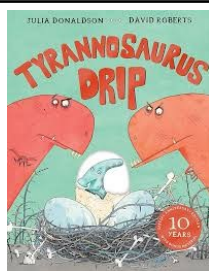

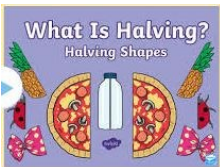


OWL CLASS
