On Thursday 19th June our lovely school photographer Helen Rayner, will be coming in to take class photos. Details of how to order copies will follow thereafter.

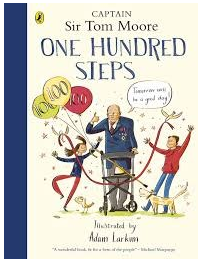
### SPORTS DAY



We have our Sports Day on Friday 27th June from 9.30am. Please come to the village green at that time to support the children. Refreshments will be available courtesy of our JSA.

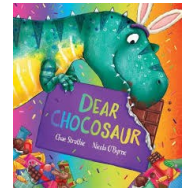
### FOX CLASS

### OWL CLASS

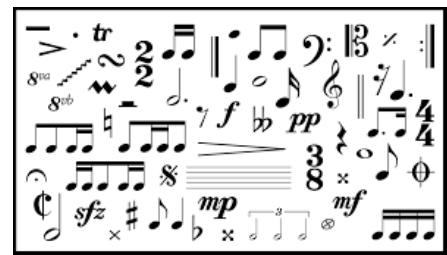
