

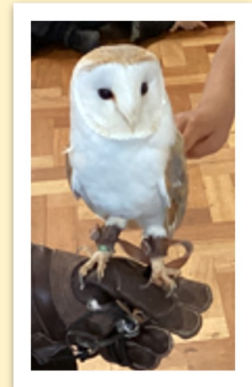

Our lovely school photographer Helen Rayner will be coming in on 19th June to take class photos. Details of how to order copies will be follow thereafter.




SPORTS DAY

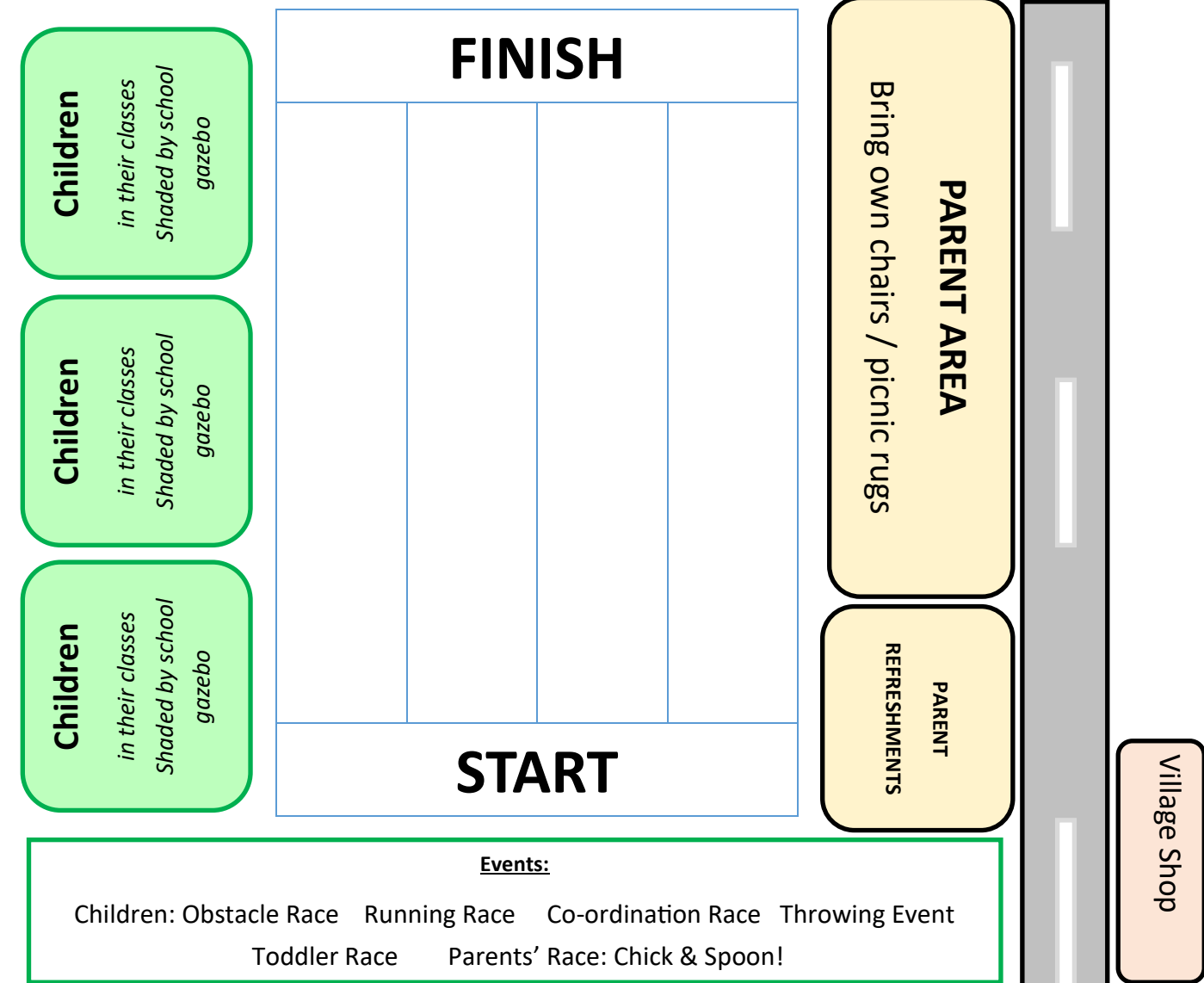




SPORTS DAY
 Friday 27th June, 9:30am - 11:30am
 Plan, Field Map & Events List

Plan:

- Bring children to school in P.E kit with a named water bottle at usual time, 8:45-9am
- Children will come up to the green in their classes at 9:30am. They will stay in their gazebo with their teacher and teaching assistants. Parents, please stay on the opposite side of the track as spectators (in the past, when parents have come over, the other children have become confused and upset with separation anxiety triggered). We will prepare the children in school so that they know that they will see you, as spectators, and will wave on arrival and then focus on watching the events, supporting their school friends.
- As part of the children’s learning about the Olympics and Paralympics, the teams are named after GB athletes.
- The JSA refreshments are available for spectators to buy– please do not buy for the children (in the interests of fairness and digestion!).
- The children will have their own water and will return to school by 12pm, ready for their cooked lunch.
- In the afternoon, the children will learn about Paralympians and take part in Paralympic activities.
- Collect children from school at 3pm, as usual.
