What an exciting day it was on Tuesday!

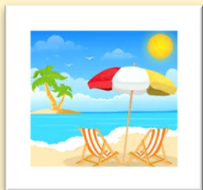

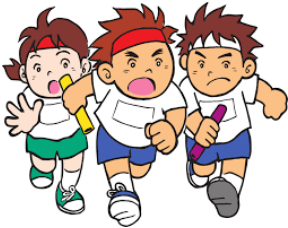


CLASS PHOTOS

YEAR 2—DROPMORE COUNTRY DANCING FESTIVAL

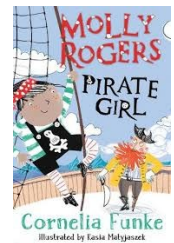

OWL CLASS

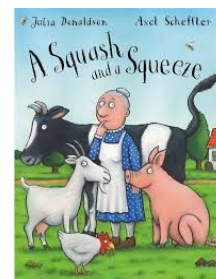
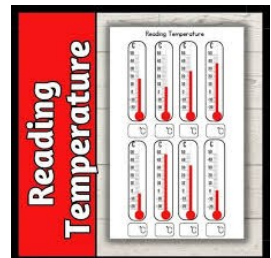
This week in Owl Class we have been learning all about money and looking at different coins and notes. In Literacy we have been reading The Sound
