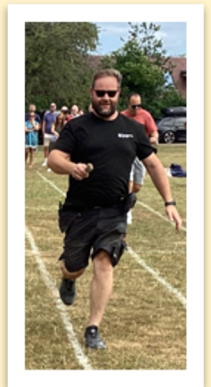
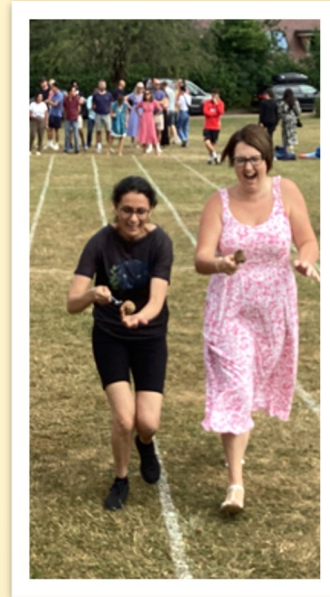

BOOK LOOKS

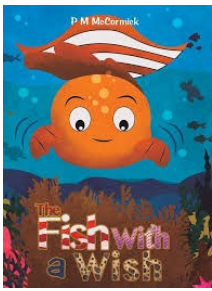
Thank you to everyone who came to their child's Book Look earlier this week. The children always love showing you their folders and it must make you very proud seeing their marvellous work.

FOX CLASS

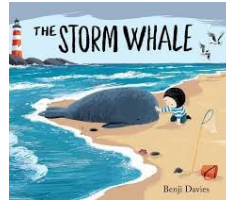


This week we have been reading *The Fish with a Wish*. In our Maths lessons, we have been measuring and comparing length and we have also been discussing ways of looking after our planet and how
