You raised an incredible £71.25 (Including Gift Aid) and we cannot thank you enough!

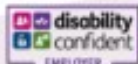

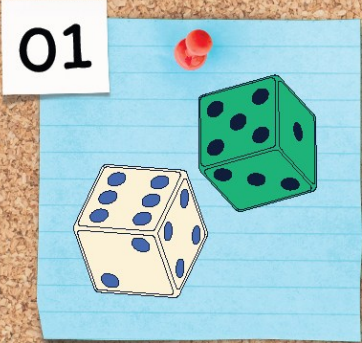

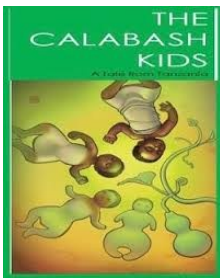
