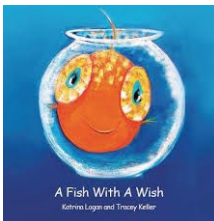


YEAR 2 LEAVERS' ASSEMBLY

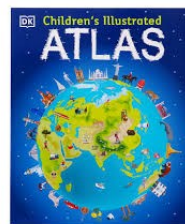
OWL CLASS
