



Welcome to Reception – Fox Class!

Reception is a great continuation of nursery and we follow the same early years curriculum. There is a good balance of adult led input and play to help your child develop in all areas and we are so excited for our new September 2025-2026 cohort!



Reading books

Next week beginning 8th September we will be sending children home with a reading record and a reading book. We will initially be sending only one book a week up until half term. Reading books will be changed every **Monday**. Please do sign your child's reading record so that we know if your child has read during the week. When listening to your child read, asking them questions, encouraging them to make predictions and discussing the book really helps them make progress. Rereading a book will also help with this.

Our Foxes will have reading books that are in line with their phonics levels and develop their skills of decoding and understanding of different texts. During the school day, we will be teaching phonics on a daily basis and will be setting tasks that promote challenge, as well as the ability to decode words, other skills such as their fluency, comprehension. Our aim is to encourage a love of reading and building up a good routine at home, for children to make predictions, as well as asking for their opinions are all important when sharing a book.

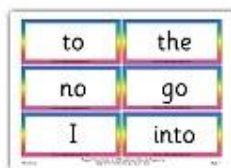


School Website and Class Pages

Google Classroom

Next week parents/carers will be sent a link to join Google Classroom. Please keep an eye out for any specific homework sheets or activities that will be uploaded once Google Classroom is up and running. These will be designed to reinforce and/ or support work we are carrying out at school. As we cover each sound in phonics, I will be uploading information for you to keep revisiting and for reference at home. We have found Google Classroom to be a very informative and efficient way of keeping up with any short notices, information linked just to Reception children/parents and any work that is carried out in school.



High Frequency Words

These are the words which are useful for children to be able to read quickly. Some of these are tricky words, they cannot be sounded out, and therefore need to be learnt on sight (rather than through blending). This will also be uploaded to Google Classroom as we progress through the year.



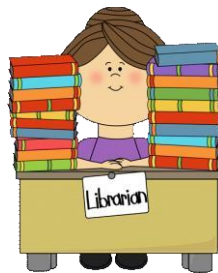
Home time

P.E.

Gymnastics will take place every Wednesday week beginning 22nd September and P.E will be every Friday. Please ensure P.E kits are in school on these days as they will be changing in school. All PE kit items should be clearly labelled with your child's name. Please do encourage changing at home too in order to develop their confidence when in school.



Library

Where possible, we will have a weekly library session every week. This will be commencing very soon once our little Foxes have settled in. Please ensure that any library books which need changing are in school on this day. More information will follow on this.



Water bottles

Please ensure your child has an 'easy access' water bottle. Some of the new steel water bottles where the top is entirely removable is tricky for the children to open and can go missing! A plastic bottle with a top where they can pull up and down is great.

11.00 – Phonics

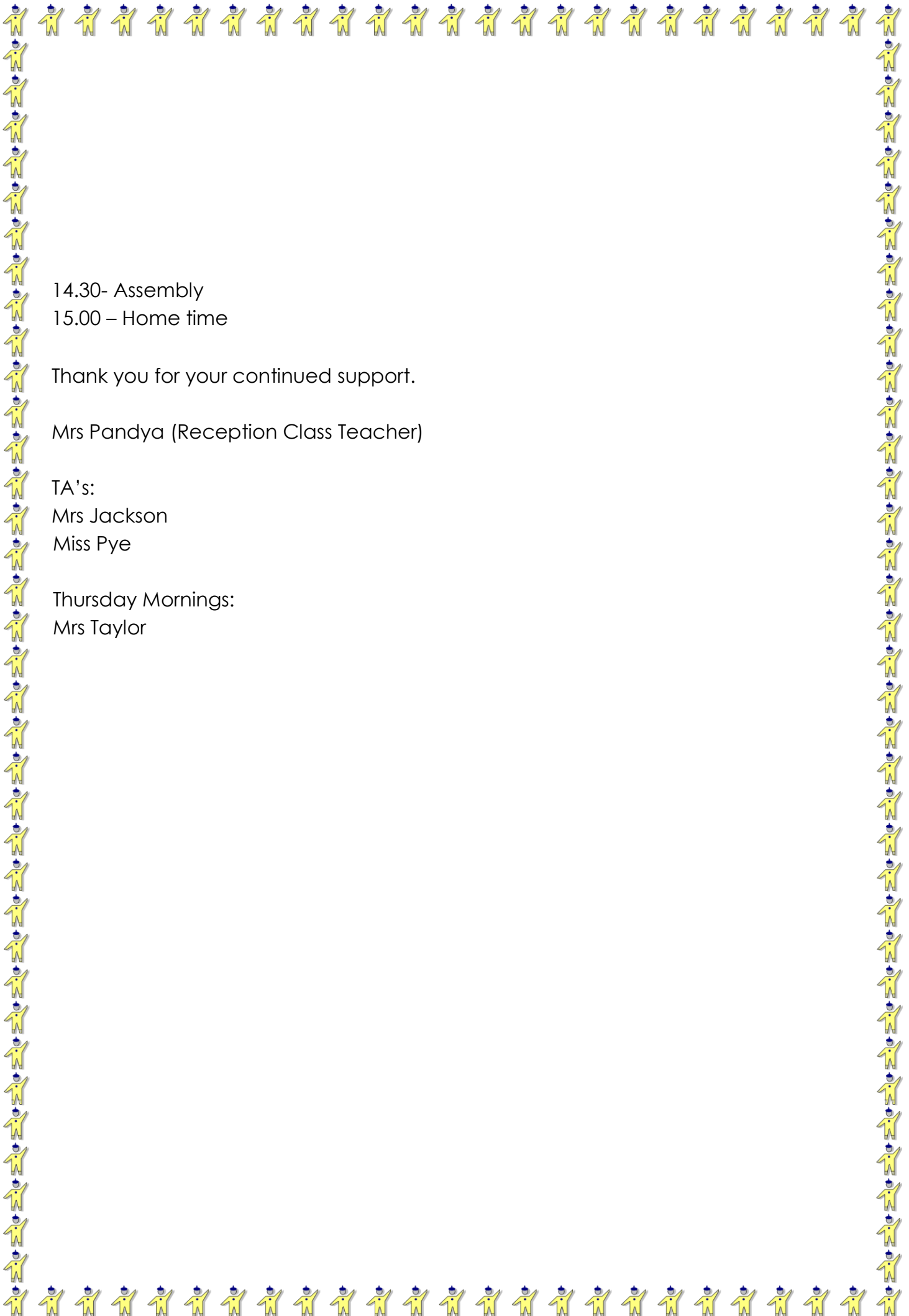
