Deer Class

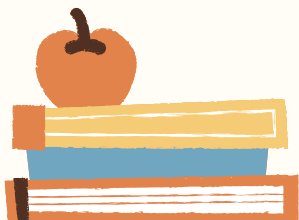

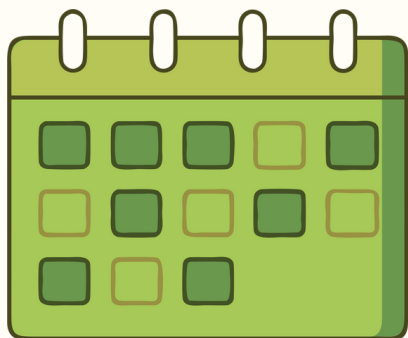

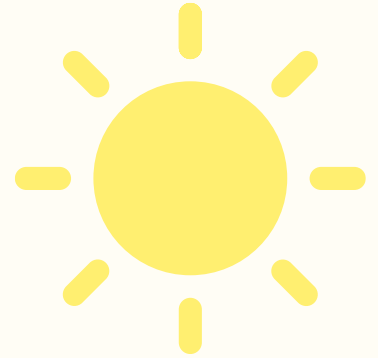
