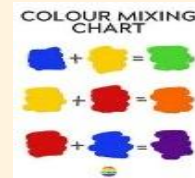
Fox Class

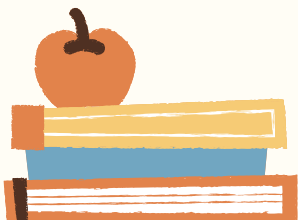

climbing... and so much more!

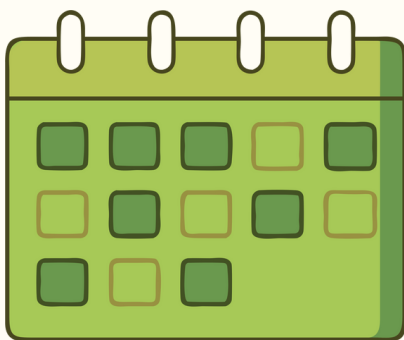
