The children had their nasal 'flu vaccinations on Wednesday. This will help to protect them and the community from 'flu over the winter months.

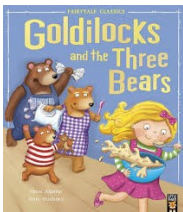


VISIT BY HEADTEACHER OF CSPA

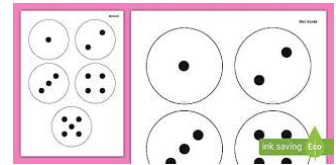
The Headteacher at CSPA will be visiting next Tuesday at 9am to talk to Yr 2 parents about the transition into Yr 3 next September.



FOX CLASS

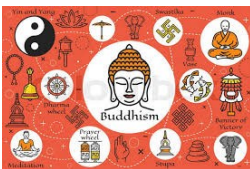

OWL CLASS

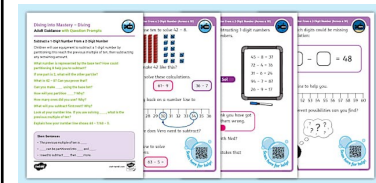
This week we have been learning about the letters ie saying igh, as in tie. In Art we have been making

- Quiet Colouring Area with a Reading Corner

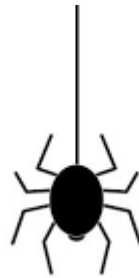
