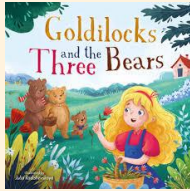

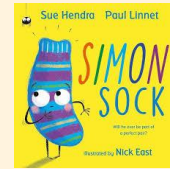
Fox Class

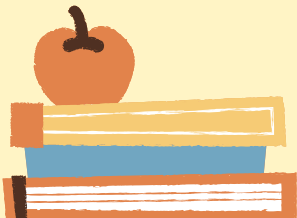

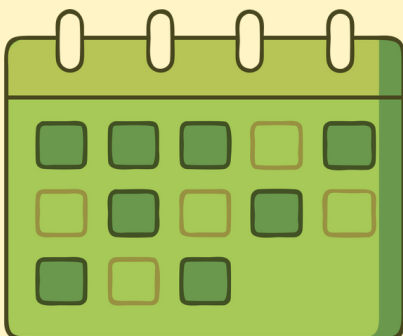

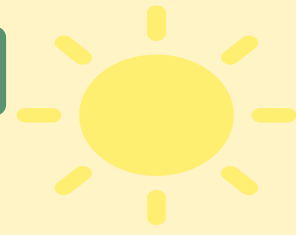
